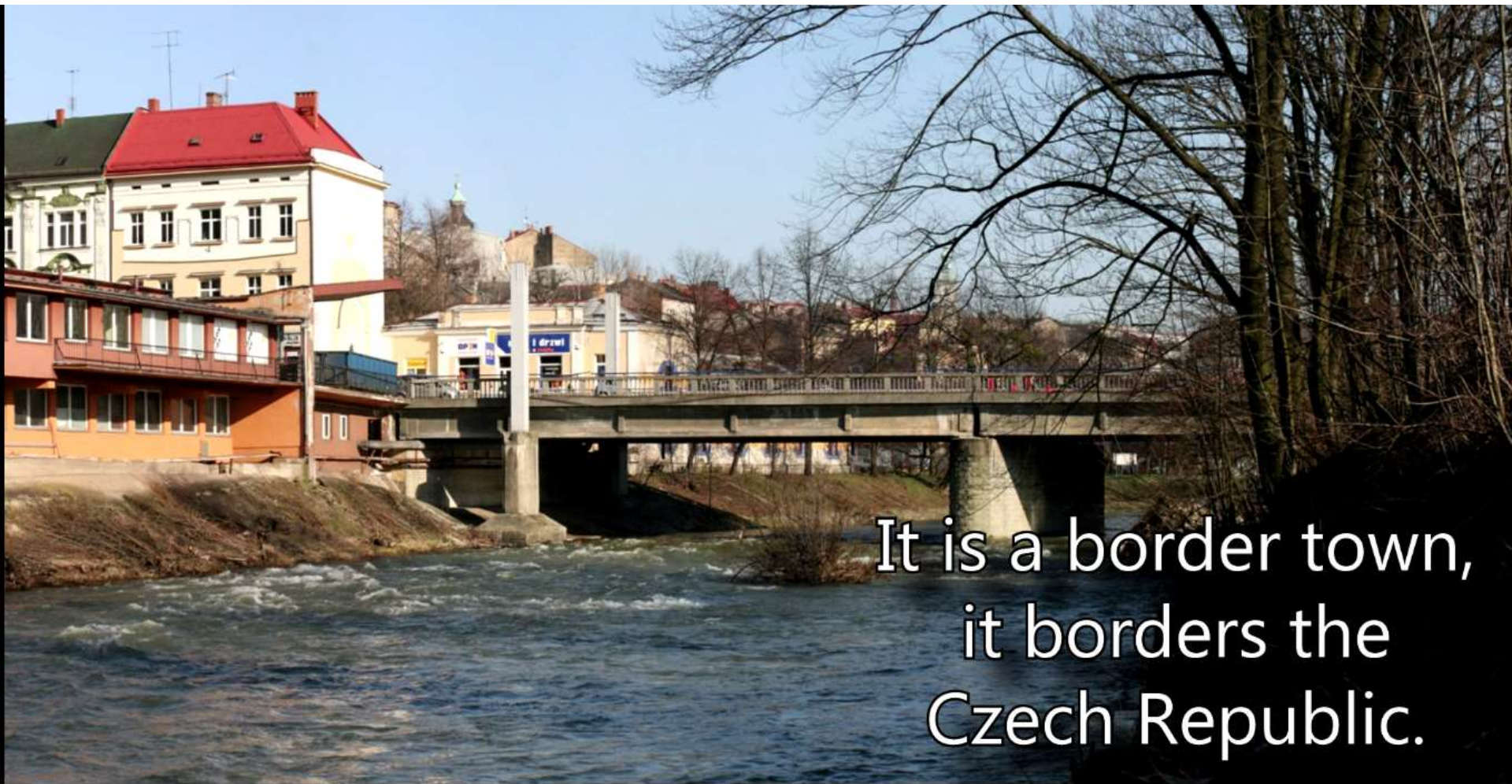

It is situated in the south-west of Poland

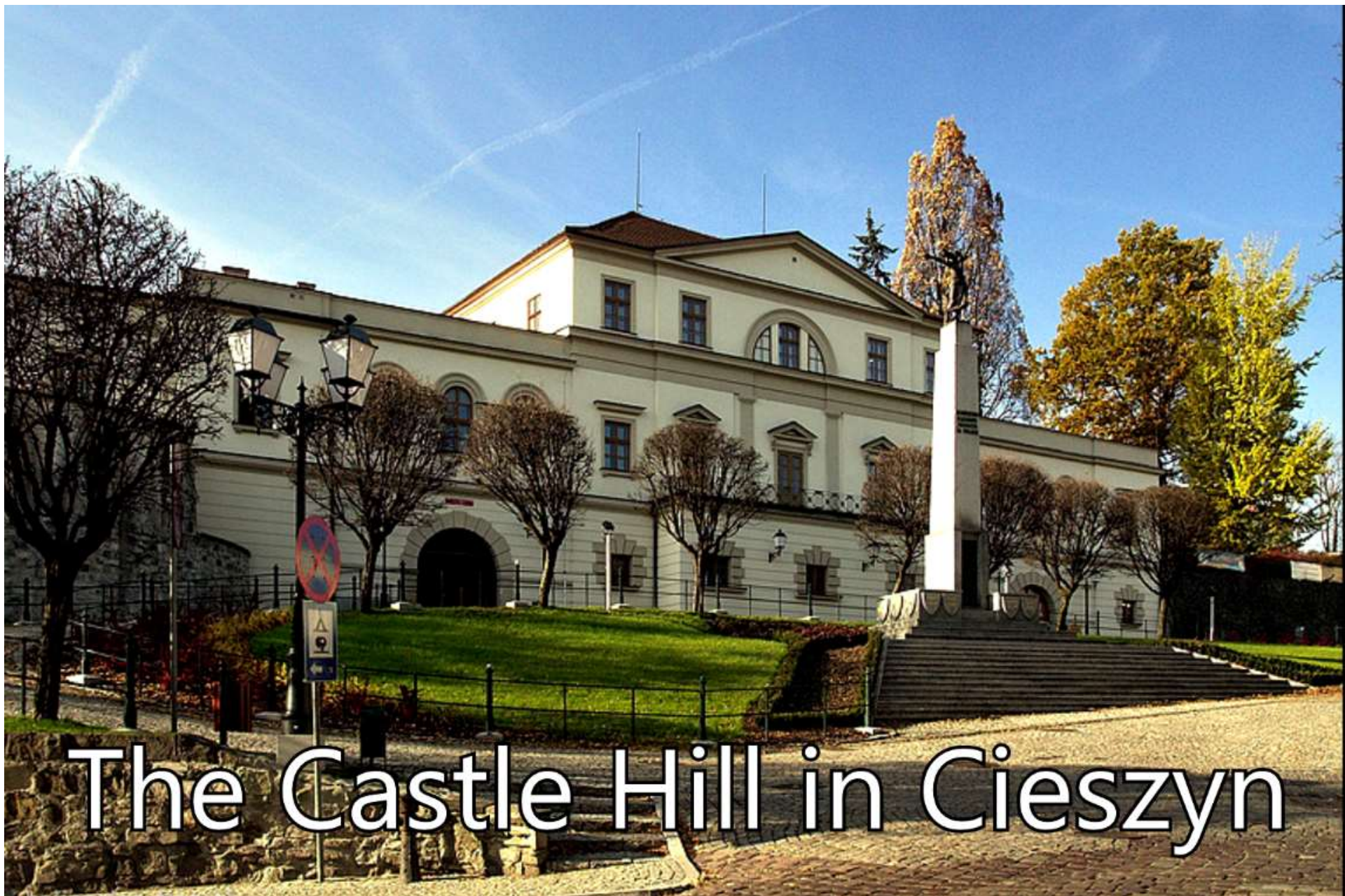




It is a border town,

because of its location.

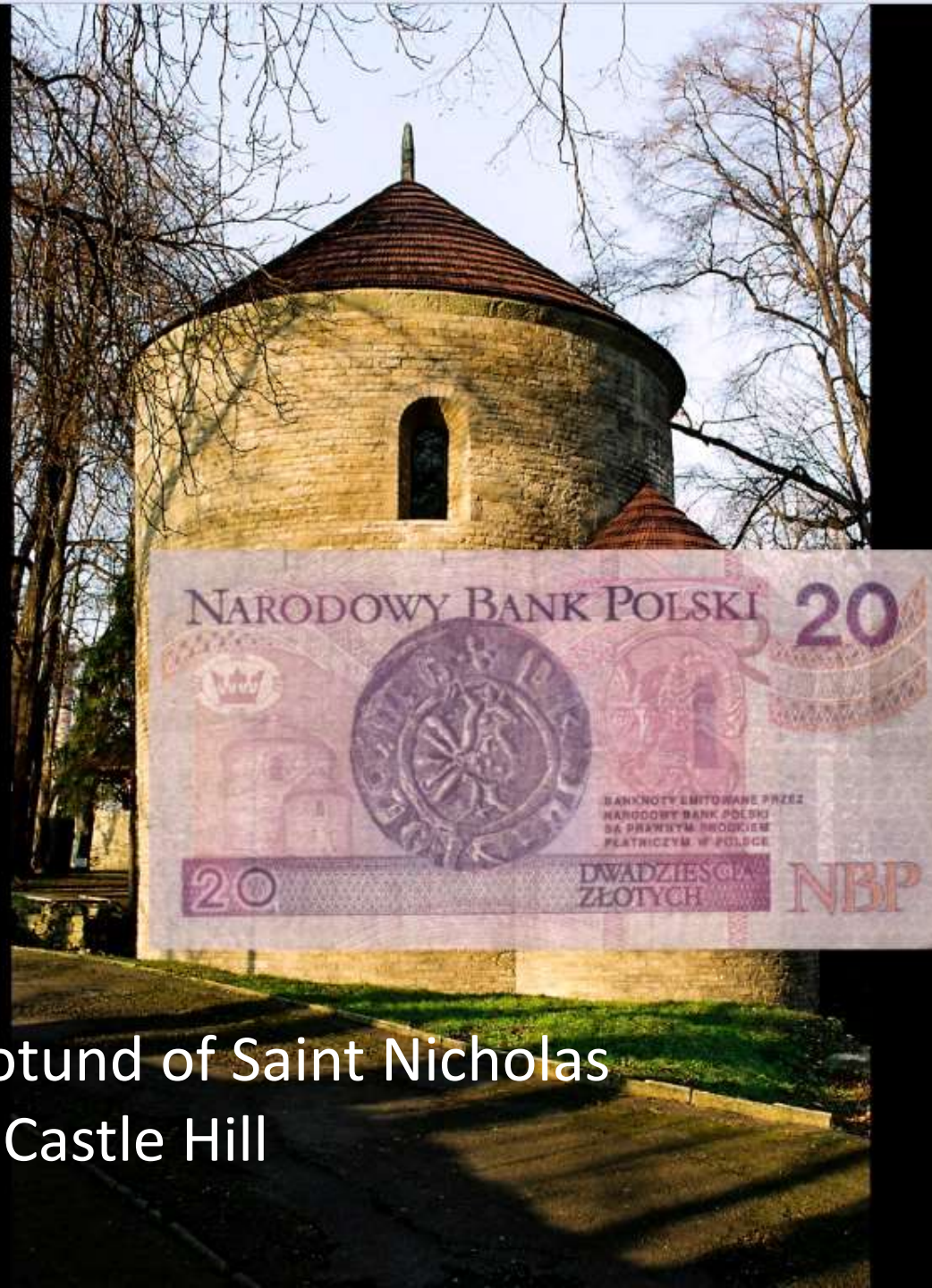




The Castle Hill in Cieszyn

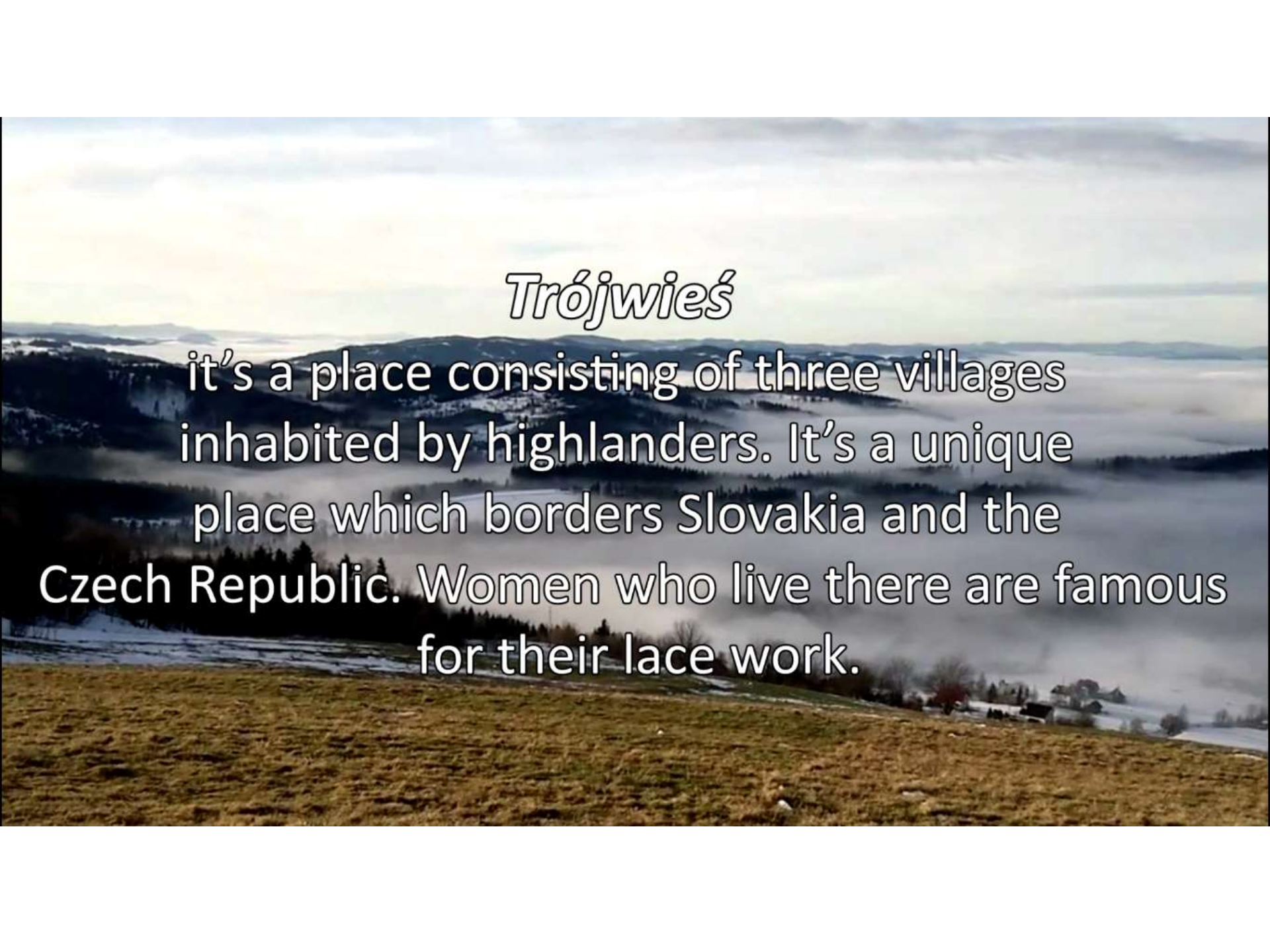




Marketplace in Cieszyn

Trójwieś

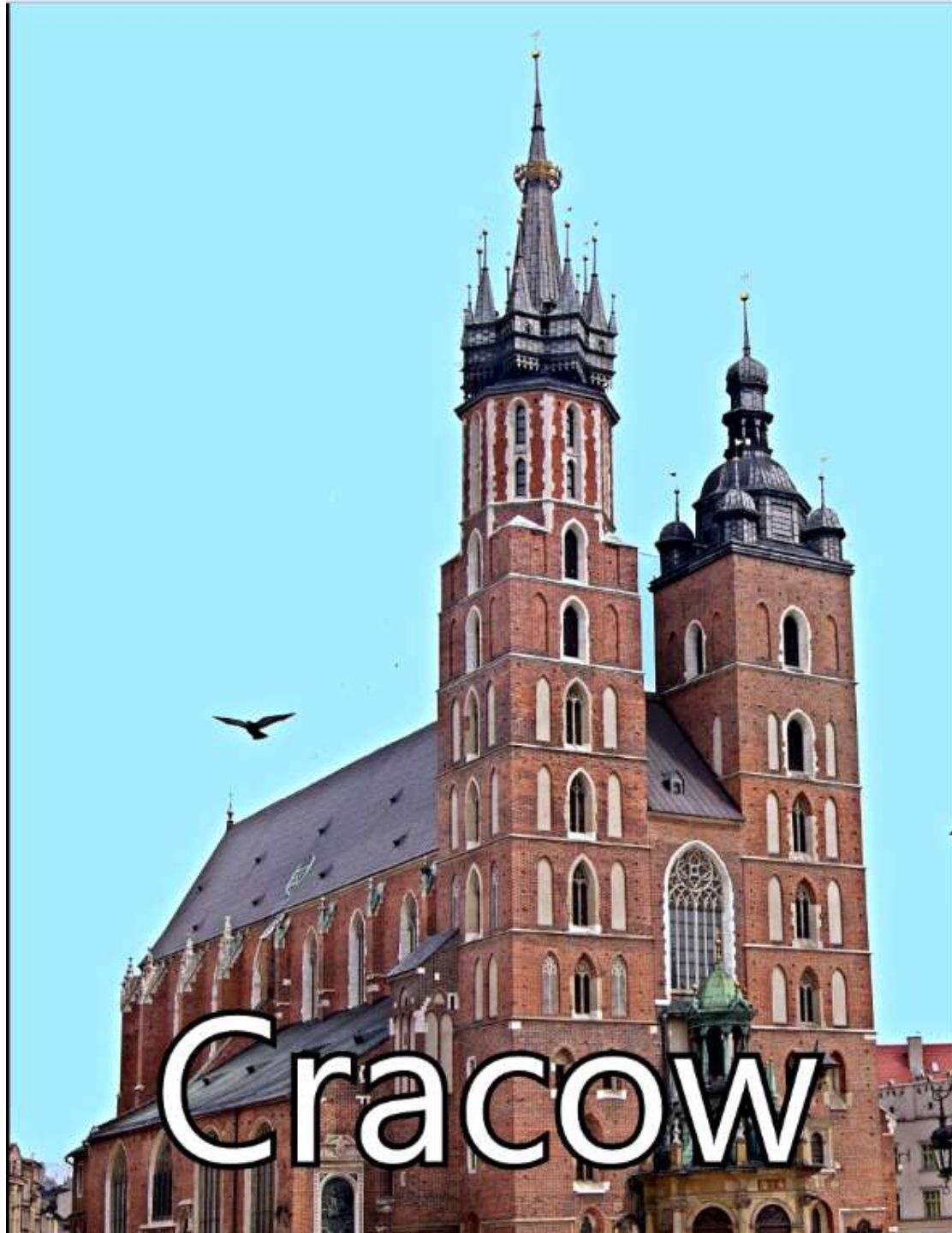

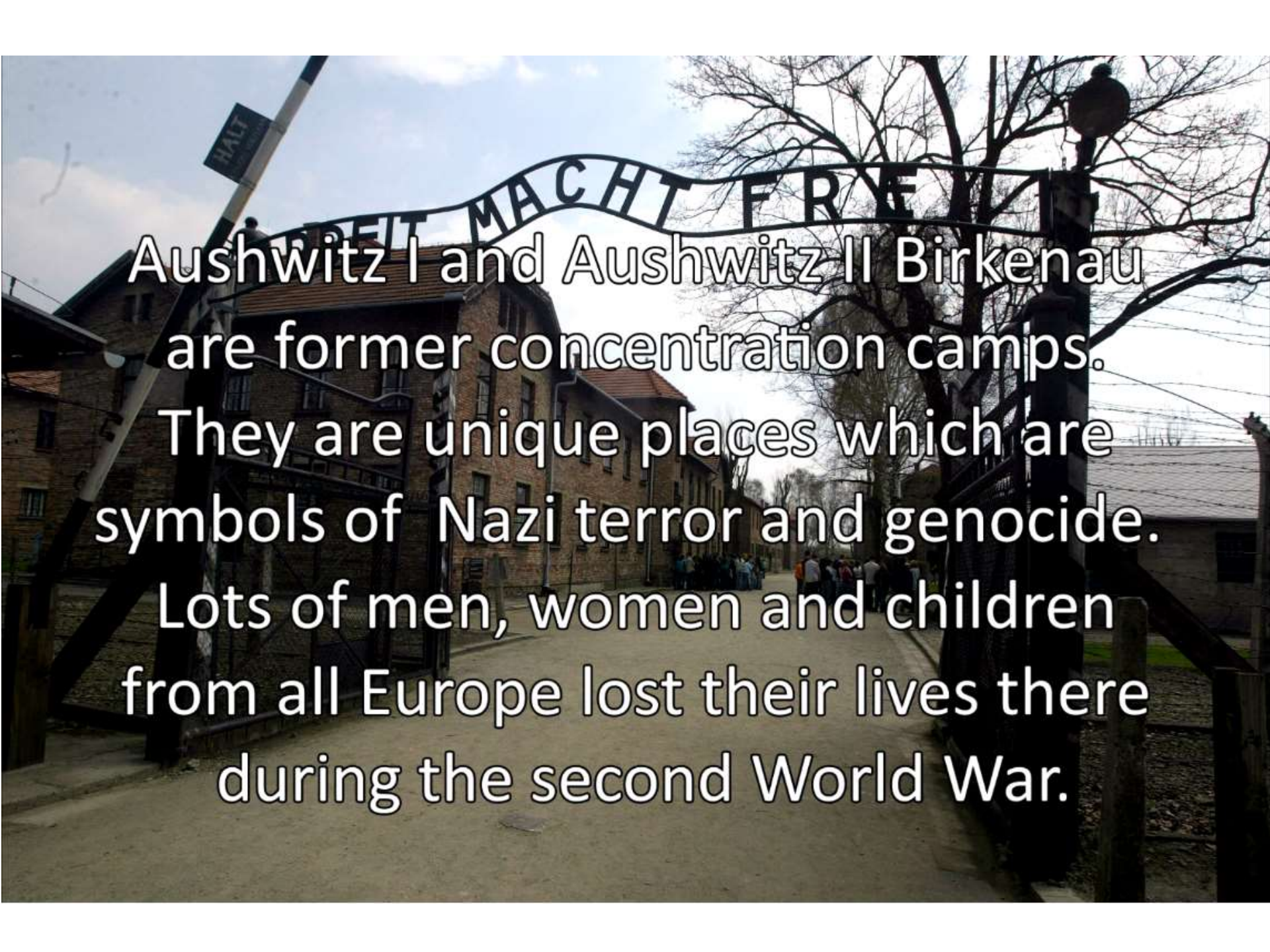
