
## TYPES OF BALLOONS




-Basic speech balloons for normal speaking - verbally.




-Shouting balloon with exclamatory verbal speech.

## Thought Balloons:




-Basic thought balloon for thinking - not verbal.




-Balloon involving imagining a picture.

## Off-panel dialogue Balloons:




-Balloon used when someone is speaking off-panel (off-screen) and whatever picture is viewed does not connect (is not aware) with said speaker.



-Balloon used when someone speaks off-panel and the person or thing pictured makes a connection (is looking at or aware of their presence) with the speaker. (note: inward tail points to where the speaker is)

## Narrative Balloons:



-Narrative speech spoken by the narrator or can be used when someone is referring to a time in the past, such as a flashback sequence.

(note: often presented as a different color and/or has thicker border)
