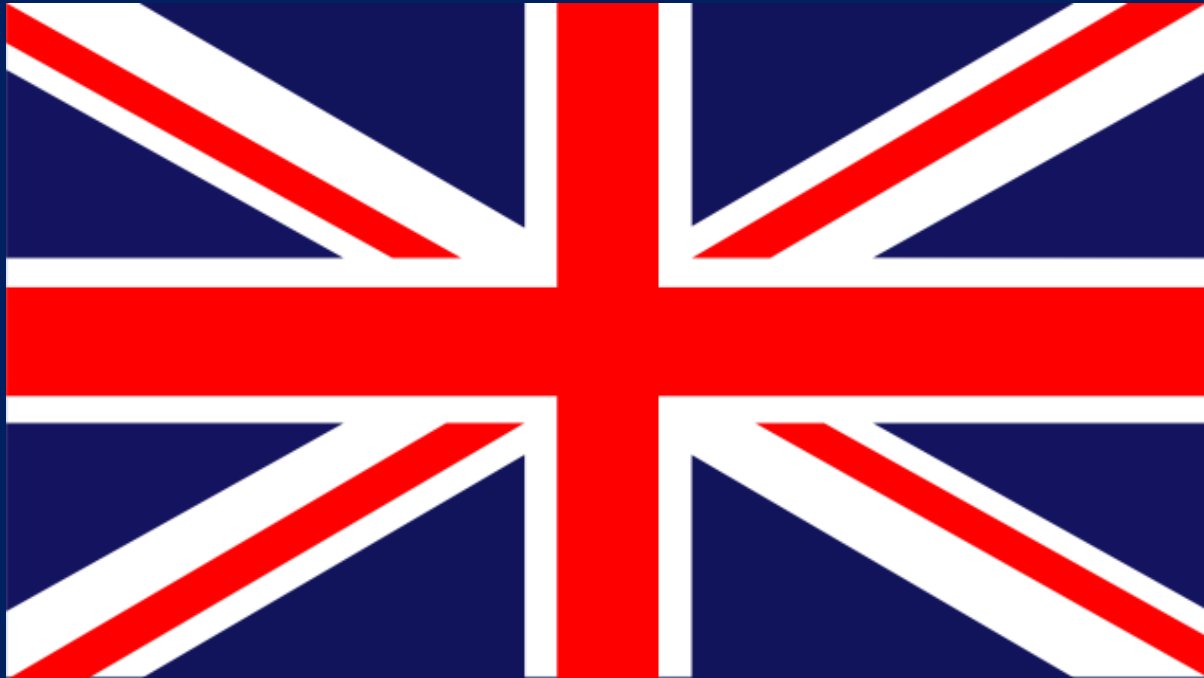

THE QUEEN

Queen Elizabeth II

Was born in 1926

Became a Queen in 1953

She was not expected to become one

The Queen is a constitutional monarch.

One of her main duties is to open the Parliament for a new working session shortly after the elections.

- ◉ Children of Prince Charles, the oldest son of the Queen and Diana, Princess of Wales.
- ◉ William is the Heir of the throne and Harry is the third one in a line.

- Princess Diana is the first wife of Prince Charles and the mother of William and Harry.
- She was very famous for her kindness and a lot of charity work all over the world.
- She was adored by the British people who all mourned when she died in a car crash in Paris in 1997.

- ◉ It is thanks to him that England won the World Cup in 1966.



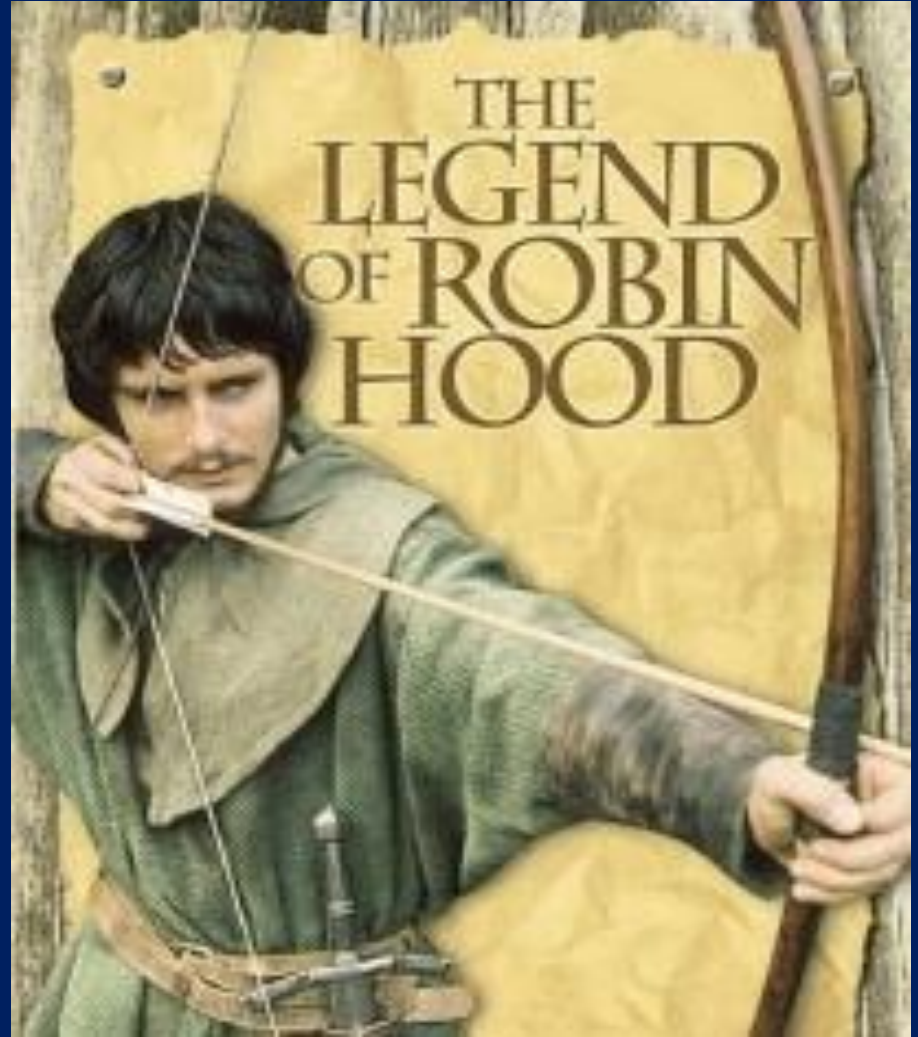
AND FOR BEING A HOME COUNTRY OF WILLIAM SHAKESPEARE

- Robin is famous for robbing the rich to feed the poor and fighting against injustice and tyranny. He lives in the Sherwood forest.
- His team and his enemy, the evil Sheriff of Nottingham are as much a part of the legend as Robin Hood himself.
- Stories about the adventures of Robin have been told and retold for over six hundred years.



THE TOWER OF LONDON

- Is a historic castle located in the centre of London.
- The Tower of London has played an important role in English history. It was attacked several times and controlling it has been important for the King to be able to control the country.

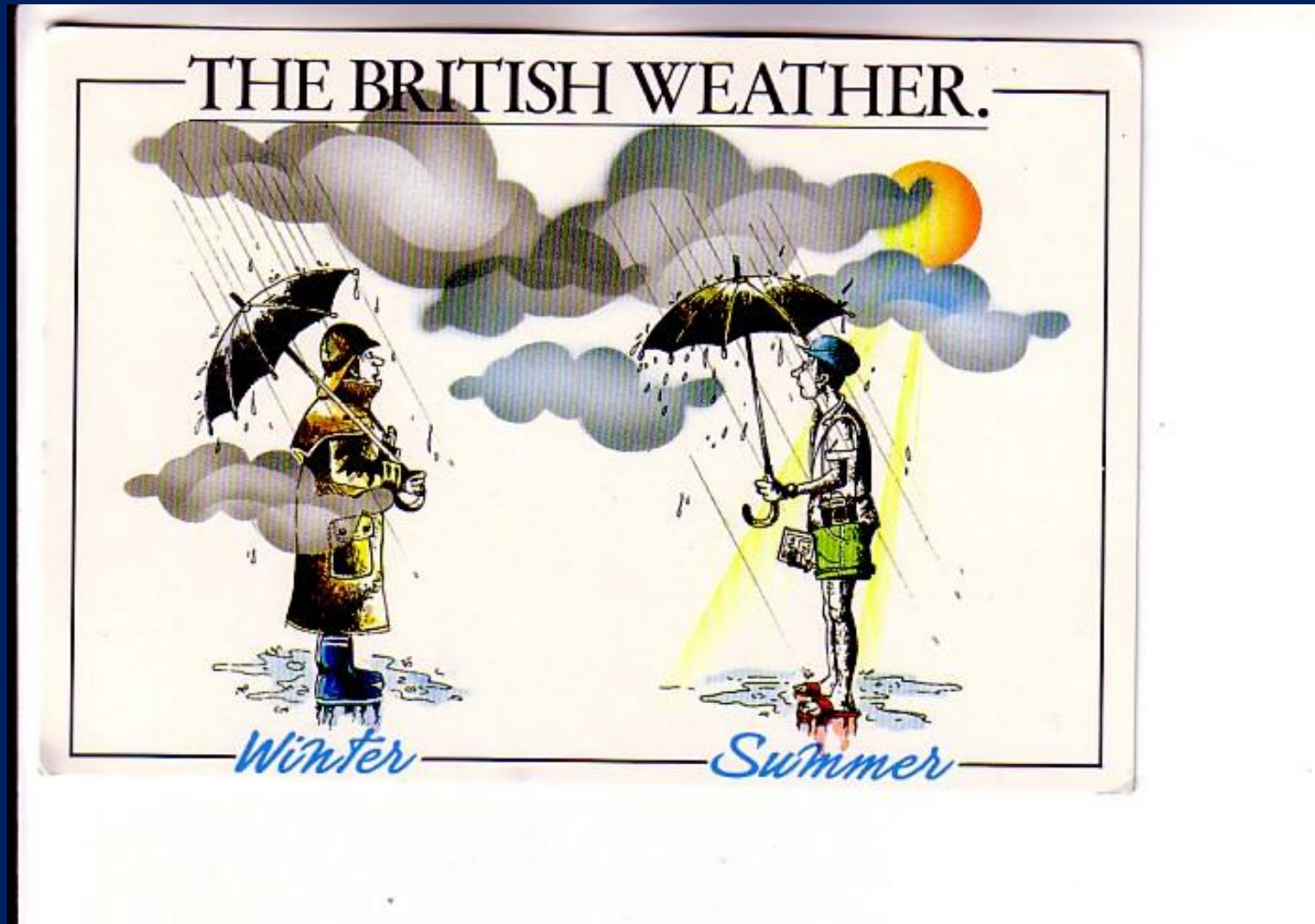


THE WESTMINSTER ABBEY
