has a B.A. in Biology and a B.A. in English Studies, as well as a University Degree in Translation (UP, France). She also possesses a Postgraduate Certificate in Open and Distance Education (OU, United Kingdom).

As a translator, she has rendered a number of **literary works** from English, French, Occitan and German.

As a writer, she has published ***La meva Europa*** (Amadeu Oller Prize for young poets, 1985), ***Berlín Zoo*** (Cassà Narrative Prize, 1991) and ***Els déus de Califòrnia*** (City of Elche Narrative Prize, 1993). Regarding the field of LabLit, she authored four juvenile novels: ***Ulls de Pantera*** (1994), ***Gelati!*** (1998), ***Roger d'Orlhac*** (2009)** and ***Pell de lluna*** (2014). She is also the author of the digital novel ***El bloc de l'Eva*** ([Eva's blog], 2009) sponsored by the Catalan Department of Education.

As a researcher, she is currently conducting a study on LabLit and gender under the patronage of the Department of Culture. A selection of her poetic work has been included in several anthologies and she has also contributed poems, translated by herself into French, in ***Forum der Schriftsteller/des Écrivains*** (1995) and in ***Le Pan des Muses*** (2012), and into English in ***Malpaís Review*** (2013).
