**STEP 2- PRE-TASK (individual work)**

The teachers give the students four cards with two positive and two negative adjectives of personality. With these adjectives students, individually, will have to create a new personality (name, job, age, hobbies, etc.) They have to include the personality adjectives in their new identities in order to find their ideal partner.

### **STEP 3- TASK- SPEED DATING (Pair/ group work)**

The teachers divide the class in two big groups. Students, in pairs, sit face to face and ask the other person questions to see if they are their ideal partner, taking into account the adjectives in their personality. After five minutes' interview, the teachers tell students time is over and then, they change partners. Students have to give a punctuation to each person they interview. Punctuation is given out of 10 points.

## STEP 4- TASK- CHOOSING YOUR IDEAL PARTNER


### (Individual/ group work)
