








# Instructions:

If you fall in a Character ( a Nobel Prize Winner) you must answer the following questions...

The 1st time: Who's he/she?

The 2nd time: Is she/he dead or alive?

The 3rd time: Where is he/she from?

The 4th time: What was his/her job?

If you fall in ? you must answer the multiple choice question from the card.

If you fall in a Millenium Development Goal, you must say aloud what is it about or answer some of the following questions:

**END POVERTY AND HUNGER** Millenium Development Goal Number 1. Tell me one country where there's big poverty and hunger and place it on the map. **UNIVERSAL EDUCATION** ( Millenium Development Goal Number 2). Countries where children work and place it on the map **GENDER EQUALITY** ( Millenium Development Goal Number 3). Translate equality/ Translate Gender/ **CHILD HEALTH** ( Millenium Development Goal Number 4). Translate child/ Translate health/ Countries where a lot of children die and place it on the map. **MATERNAL HEALTH** ( Millenium Development Goal number 5) what does health mean?. **COMBAT HIV/AIDS** ( Millenium Development Goal number 6) what is AIDS, translate? **ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY** ( Millenium Development Goal number 7) Say one environmental Problem. **GLOBAL PARTNERSHIP** ( Millenium Development Goal number 8) this is a difficult one... explain what it means.

In the rest of squares do what is written: sometimes you must identify a symbol, others move forward or backwards, point a country in the map...
