- But most adjectives with two syllables form the comparative with [more + than].

 expensive > more expensive example: Intel processors are more expensive that ADM processors.
- The superlatives forms use [the -est in/ of]. They are formed as the comparatives do.

 fast > the fastest | big > the biggest | happy > the happiest | expensive > the most expensive |
 examples: This is the most expensive video controller in the PC market. This is the fastest of all computers.
- We also use *more* +than and less +than with nouns, to compare their quantity.

 My new hard-disk has much more memory than my old one. My old hard-disk had less memory.
- We also use less with adjectives.

 ADM processors are less expensive than Intel processors.
