Monday of October.

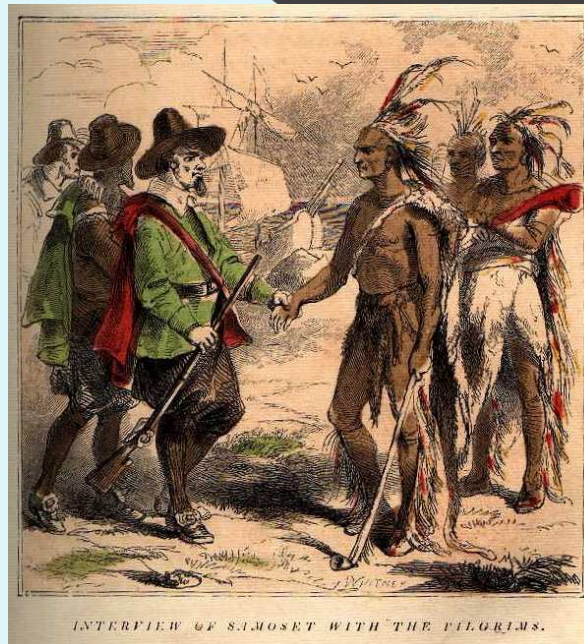


Origin

- The legendary Pilgrims, come from Ireland and they crossed the Atlantic in the year 1620 with a ship called Mayflower.

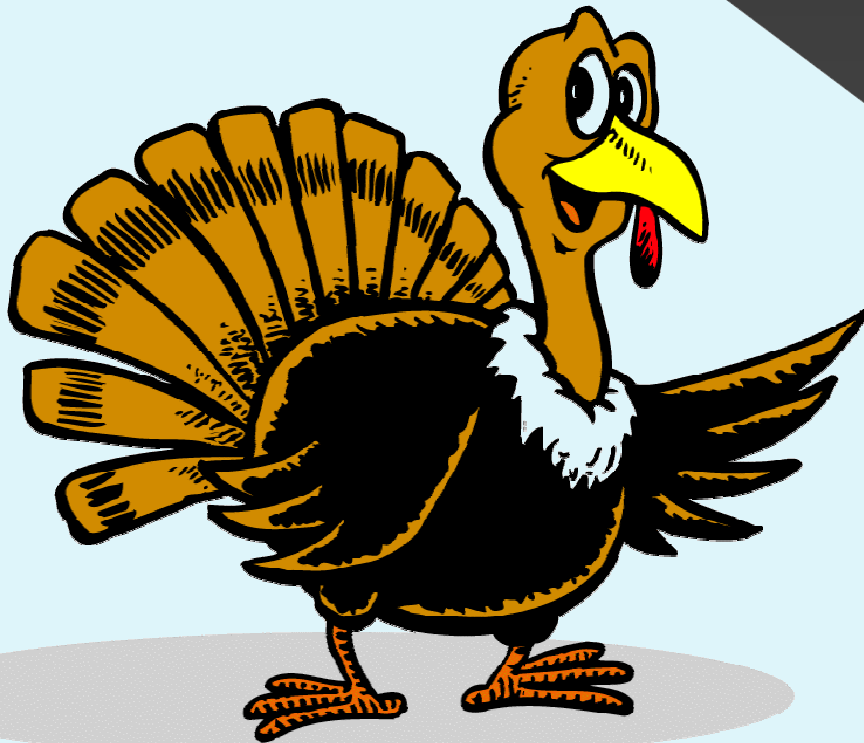


- ◉ When they arrived in America the Indians help them. Pilgrims invited the Indians to a celebration dinner to thank them.
