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

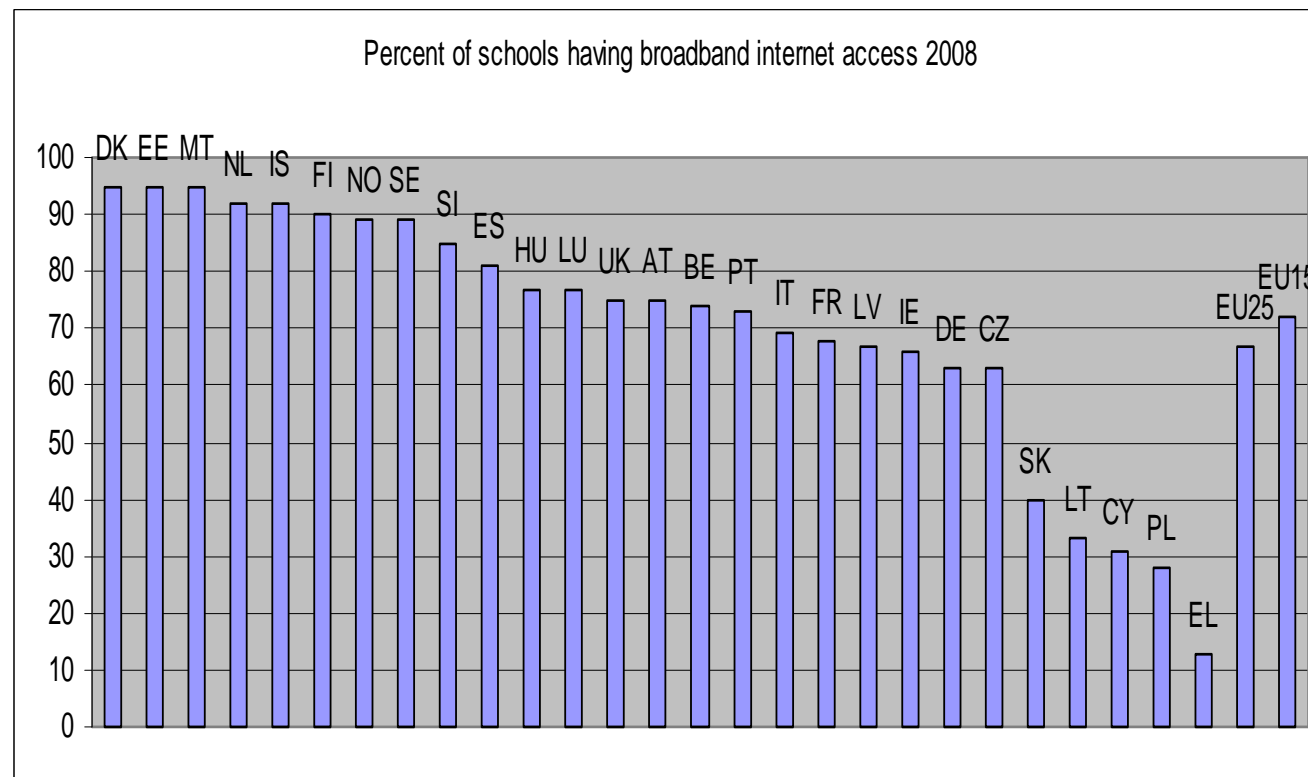

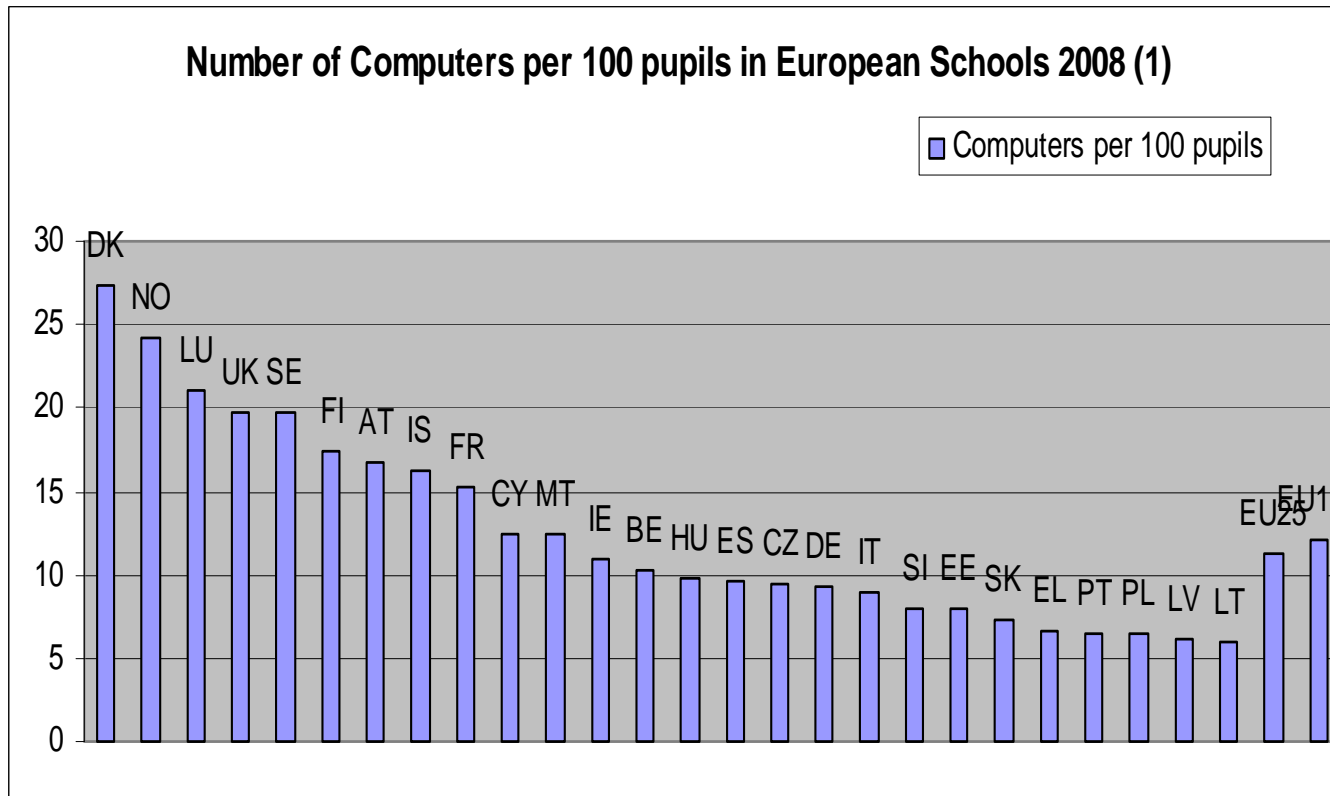


*Access to ICT and the Internet in European Schools

Are socio-cultural factors taken into account that either promote or discourage digital inclusion and e-learning in e-policy planning ?





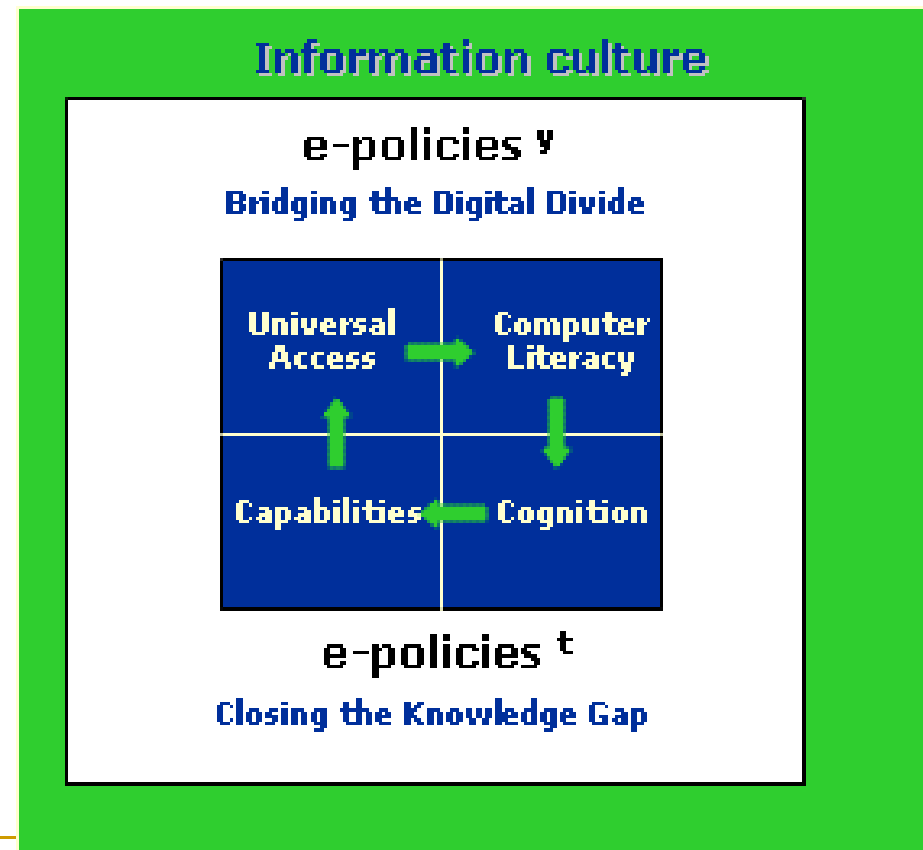


Conclusions and Recommendation
